



## Achieve Vocational/Community College Scholarship Application Form

The Geneva Women's Club is a not-for-profit philanthropic women's organization dedicated to improving the lives of families in the Fox Valley area.

In May of 2020 the Geneva Women's Club (GWC) will award an academic scholarship valued at up to \$1000 to a Geneva High School student from the senior graduating class or a previous Geneva High School graduate who has enrolled and will attend an accredited non-profit community college or accredited vocational/trade school. The scholarship winner will be selected by a committee of GWC members who will review all applications received at [genevahsscholarships@gmail.com](mailto:genevahsscholarships@gmail.com) on or before the deadline of April 24, 2020.

Scholarship winners will be selected based on:

- Enrollment in accredited community college or vocational/trade school
- Minimum GPA 2.0
- Estimated Family Contribution (EFC) indicated on the applicant's parents 2019-2020 FAFSA application or acceptable financial statement
- Recommendation letter from teacher, counselor, or employer
- Personal statement in response to the following 3 application questions:
  - Who or what inspired you to follow this career, and how?
  - What type of job do you want after graduating through this career track?
  - How will you contribute to your community? This can include family obligations.

Scholarship winners will be notified via telephone by April 30, 2020. Scholarship certificates will be awarded at the Geneva High School Senior Awards night on May 13, 2020.

3. The one page double spaced questions and answers as described above
4. Any other documents, such as a resume, that the application deems relevant.
